Avoidance

- Conduct operations responsibly in all areas, specifically to avoid adverse impacts to the environment.

Minimization

- Conduct site selection and design of any infrastructure including surface leases, facilities and pipeline rights of way that minimizes Peyto's disturbance footprint.
- Reduce and mitigate environmental releases or spills in accordance with Peyto's HSE policy and current regulatory requirements.

Restoration

- Responsibly manage asset retirement obligations (ARO) by having a liability management plan in place.
- Actively reclaim sites back to equivalent capability in a timely manner in accordance with regulatory requirements.
- Actively remediate any contamination to support ongoing reclamation efforts.
